



Make your own Bird Feeder

Get your garden ready for Autumn with this fun and easy to make bird feeder



You will need:

- String
- A slice of bread. If it's a bit stale or a crust, even better
- Shape cutter, Scissors or a Knife (and an adult)
- Peanut Butter
- Nuts, seeds, raisins or anything else you think the birds might like

With the help of an adult, use a shape cutter to cut out a shape in the bread. You can also use scissors or a knife. Then, poke a hole in the top, big enough for the string to go through. (Be careful not to split the bread when you are doing this)

Cover one side of the shape in peanut butter

Stick as much bird food as you can onto the peanut butter.
Be creative, can you make a nice pattern for the birds to enjoy whilst they have their dinner?

Poke the string through the hole and make a loop. Hang it on a branch outside.

Sit back and wait for the birds to come!
